

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. The loan payable balance on the cover summary page of the January 10, 2009 report indicates \$42,400.00 is owed to the candidate, however, \$2,400 was repaid to the candidate leaving a loan payable balance of \$37,600.00. An amended cover summary page must be filed with the correct loan payable balance.

2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the January 10, 2009 report lists the contributor for two \$500 entries as "Pay Pal Funds-Variou". The report indicates all pay pal funds are under \$100. However, if any of the pay pal contributions are over \$50, they must be itemized on an amended Schedule A. If all of the pay pal contributions were \$50 or under, please indicate that fact in a letter of amendment to the January 10, 2009 report.

3. K.S.A. 25-4148 (b) (7) requires that when an expenditure is made by payment to an advertising agency, public relations firm or political consultants for disbursement to vendors, the report of such expenditure shall show in detail the name of each such vendor and the amount, date and purpose of the payment to each. Expenditures amounting to \$6445 were made to Mid Con Marketing for advertising. Please submit the required supplemental information as an amendment to Schedule C on the January 10, 2009 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
