

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) indicates your campaign accepted the following cash contribution over \$100:

K.S.A. 25-4153(i) states, "No person shall make any contribution or contributions to any candidate or the candidate committee of any candidate in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 for any one primary or general election, and no candidate or candidate committee of any candidate shall accept any contribution or contributions in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 from any one person for any one primary or general election."

The cash contribution listed above should not have been accepted by the campaign. In the future, you must be certain that all contributions in excess of \$100 are made by check, cashier's check or money order.

2. The Campaign Finance Act requires that any contribution from an individual in excess of \$150 must be accompanied by the **occupation and industry** of the individual. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the report does not reflect both the occupation and industry of the individual donors. The report must be amended to show both the occupation and the industry of all contributors who gave in excess of \$150.

3. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2009 report lists expenditures on 11-19-08 to Triplett, Woolf, Garretson for \$764.80 and to Emery Goad on 12-27-08 in the amount of \$105 for legal fees. It will be necessary for you to provide more information concerning these expenditures. This information can be disclosed in a letter of amendment to the January 10, 2009 report.

4. The loan payable balance on the cover summary page of the October 27, 2008 report indicates \$12,440.03 is owed to Steve and Nola Foulston, however, \$8262.43 was repaid to Steve Foulston during this reporting period leaving a loan payable balance of \$4177.60. An amended cover summary page must be filed with the correct loan payable balance.
