In checking with the Secretary of State, we have been informed that you have failed to file the amended Receipts and Expenditures Report identified above as required by law. The amended report must be completed and filed within five (5) days from the date of receipt of this notice.

As provided by K.S.A. 25-4152, you shall have 15 days from the date of this notice (or until December 16, 2020) to comply with the reporting requirements before a civil penalty shall be imposed for each day the required document remains unfiled. The penalty shall be ten dollars (\$10) per day for each day the report remains unfiled, except that no civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required report within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required report has been filed.

File the required report within five (5) days with the Secretary of State. As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your candidate's record in the Secretary of State's Office.
