

The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 25, 2010 report lists expenditures totaling \$3562.11, yet Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) lists \$1100 in contributions for the October reporting period and \$90.00 from the July reporting period with cash available this period in the amount of \$1190.00. An amended October 25, 2010 report must be filed disclosing the source of funds used to make \$2372.11 in expenditures. If any expenditures were made from personal funds, not campaign funds, they must be listed on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) and removed from Schedule C.

2. In reviewing the October 25, 2010 report we find that neither Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) nor Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) contain addresses. The report must be amended to include street or mailing addresses on both schedules.

3. The October 25, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report contains activity from the July 26, 2010 reporting period. An amended October 25, 2010 report must be filed removing any activity that occurred from January 1, 2010 through July 22, 2010 which was previously reported on the July 26, 2010. Only activity that occurred from July 23, 2010 through October 21, 2010 should be listed on the October 25, 2010 report.

4. K.S.A. 25-4148 (b) (7) requires that when an expenditure is made by payment to an advertising agency, public relations firm or political consultants for disbursement to vendors, the report of such expenditure shall show in detail the name of each such vendor and the amount, date and purpose of the payment to each. An expenditure amounting to \$3145.50 was made to My Classified Ads LLC on 10-6-10. Please submit the required supplemental information as an amendment to Schedule C on the October 25, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
