
Dear Carol:

This letter is in response to the inquiry made by the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission concerning a check that I supposedly received from the Builder's Association PAC for \$100.00 in December of 2006.

As I told you on the telephone, there was a check that came in but I could not contact the individual who sent it, and I did not know who they were. I put the check back in the envelope, and have looked for it numerous times after December, but I could not find it. The only thing I can think of is that the opened envelope with the check in it was inadvertently discarded in the wastebasket. I called several lobbyists, including the Builder's Association, and they have all responded that they did not send a check to me. However, you identified one individual who you tried to check with, I believe it is a female lobbyist, and I think you informed me that she does not return your calls. Please, if you need to, I would like to see if the check has been cashed; although I doubt very seriously if it has been, and if it has been cashed, I would like for them to produce the endorsement for handwriting comparison. My account has never seen that check, nor have I seen it since I placed it back in the envelope. Therefore, even though I did receive a check, it was lost and they should be able to tell us if anything has happened they have a right to stop payment on the check.

My treasurer is going to come to your office directly because we are having a problem resolving the second question, and I have a pressing issue that I have to take care of this morning. Therefore, my treasurer, Ann Golubski, will be in your office on Wednesday, October 24th. Thank you very much.
