and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, ... \$500 for each primary election ... and an equal amount for each general election." The Otto campaign reported receiving a \$500 contribution on 8-15-08 from Union Pacific Railroad, and \$200 on 10-1-08, for a total of \$700. Both of these contributions were received during the general election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$200. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
