Dear Mr. Freeman:

The January 10, 2011 Receipts & Expenditures Report that was filed on behalf of your campaign indicated it was to be a termination report. However, the Campaign Finance Act provides that you may not terminate until such time as all funds are expended and any debts or obligations are paid or forgiven. The report indicated the cash on hand at close of period was \$52.38.

The July 26, 2010 report lists a loan payable to you in the amount of \$300.00. If you want to terminate the campaign, the loan payable balance to you in the amount of \$300.00 must be forgiven and the disbursement of the remaining \$52.38 must be explained in a letter to the Commission. You may do so at the bottom of this letter and return it to our office. Otherwise, your treasurer will be required to file yearly reports for your campaign.
