K.S.A. 25-4153a states that no registered lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual, shall make a contribution and no legislator or candidate for the legislature shall accept a contribution from a lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual after January 1 and prior to sine die adjournment of the regular session of the legislature or any other time the legislature is in session. This campaign donation to the recognized political party committee should not have been given. It will be necessary for the Garber campaign to contact the Republican House Campaign Committee for a refund. The return of this donation must be shown on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the October 29, 2012 report.

In response to item #2 above the Republican House Campaign Committee did not cash the \$100.00 check dated 1/9/2012 on Schedule C of my July 30, 2012 report. As per phone conversation with Karina Renna I will report it as such on the October ethics report.
