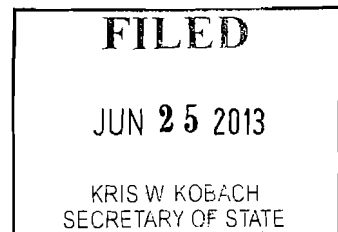

RE: Material Error or Omission in a Receipts and Expenditures Report

I am replying on behalf of the Grant Randall for State Representative 2012 campaign. My former treasurer was contacted concerning an error in our expenditures report in late April. In an official reply he let the Secretary of State know that as of the last report, he was no longer affiliated with the campaign and that the account had been closed. This information was then forwarded to the campaign address. As this address was not a residence, and I have been traveling for work, I only recently was able to go over these notices. I found that pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign had indeed accepted contributions in excess of the legal limit in the amount of \$200, from D Wild Ones PAC.

As stated, the campaign account has been closed, so I will be making this payment from my personal account. I have included a copy of the check with this letter, and will ask D Wild Ones to provide the appropriate documentation to show that this check was cashed.

Please let me know if further action need be taken.
