Dear Ms. Shulda:

The January 10, 2013 Receipts & Expenditures Report that was filed on behalf of your campaign indicated it was to be a termination report. However, the Campaign Finance Act provides that you may not terminate until such time as all funds are expended and any debts or obligations are paid or forgiven.

Since a \$500 contribution was not reported on the October 29, 2012, your cash on hand at the close of period for the January 10, 2013 report is \$500, not \$0 as indicated.

The October 29, 2012 report lists loan payables to you and Brian Shulda in the amount of \$410.18. If you want to terminate the campaign, the loan payable balance must be forgiven and the disbursement of the \$500 must be explained in a letter to the Commission. You may do so at the bottom of this letter and return it to our office. Otherwise, your treasurer will be required to file yearly reports for your campaign.
