- 1. The beginning balance of \$18,148.63 listed on the January 10, 2015 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$17,901.13 listed on the October 27, 2014 report. This difference of \$1057.50 must be explained in an amended report.
- 2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the January 10, 2015 report lists two \$250 contributions from Microsoft Corp. on 10-27-14 and on 10-30-14. It appears this contribution from Microsoft Corp. is a duplicate entry since they report giving only one \$250 contribution to the Kasha Kelley campaign on 10-16-14. If this is a duplicate entry, an amended Schedule A for the January 10, 2015 report must be filed removing one of the contributions.
