1. K.S.A. 25-4153a states that no registered lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual, shall make a contribution and no legislator or candidate for the legislature shall accept a contribution from a lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual after January 1 and prior to sine die adjournment of the regular session of the legislature or any other time the legislature is in session. If these contributions were actually received on January 3, 2017, these contributions should not have been accepted and must be returned. The return of these contributions must be shown on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2018 report.
