

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. According to the January 10, 2016 report filed by the Kansas Chamber of Commerce Jobs PAC, they report giving a \$100 in-kind contribution for a voter list to the Marvin KleeB campaign. If the campaign received this voter list, an amended Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) must be filed listing this in-kind contribution.

2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the January 10, 2016 report lists a \$150 contribution being received on 3-25-15 from Verizon. K.S.A. 25-4153a states that no registered lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual, shall make a contribution and no legislator or candidate for the legislature shall accept a contribution from a lobbyist, political committee or person, other than an individual after January 1 and prior to sine die adjournment of the regular session of the legislature or any other time the legislature is in session. This contribution should not have been accepted and should be returned. The return of this contribution must be shown on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 25, 2016 report.
