Administration of Campaign Finance, Conflict of Interest & Lobbying Laws K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Kessinger campaign reported receiving a \$150 contribution on 12-30-19, and a \$500 contribution on 7-31-20 from the Heavy Constructors Association PAC, for a total of \$650. Both of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$150. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. <u>Since</u> the campaign account is closed, it will be necessary for the candidate to personally reimburse the \$150 excess contribution to the Heavy Constructors Association PAC. A copy of the cancelled check must be provided to the Commission.
