1. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee... shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election... and an equal amount for each general election." The Finch campaign reported receiving a \$250 contribution on 12-26-19, and a \$500 contribution on 7-24-20 from the Kansas Optometric PAC, for a total of 750. Both of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$250. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2022 Receipts and Expenditures Report.

2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 26, 2020 report lists the following expenditures with the purpose listed as reimbursement for campaign expenses:
