According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Humane Society Legislative Fund of KS PAC reports making a \$200 contribution to Sydney Carlin on 12-19-19 and Enterprise holdings Inc. PAC reports making a \$250 contribution on 11-7-19. These contributions were not reported by your campaign. If these contributions were received, they must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2020 report. This error will cause the cash balance on the front page summary sheet to be incorrect. Therefore, an amended front page summary sheet must also be filed. If the campaign did not receive these contributions, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

manner since these would be illegal contributions. An explanation of these entries must be provided in a letter to the Commission.

4.
