- 1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Kansas Agri Business Council reports making one, \$200 contribution to Daniel Hawkins on 8-26-20 for the general election period. However, the Hawkins campaign reports receiving two, \$200 contributions from the Kansas Agri Business Council on 8-31-20 and on 11-2-20. If the campaign did not receive the second contribution, an amended Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) for the January 10, 2021 must be filed removing this contribution. If the campaign did receive this contribution, no amendment is necessary for Schedule A.
- 2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2021 report lists credit card payments to Capital One during the reporting period. K.S.A. 25-4148(b)(7) states the report must show the name and address of each person to whom expenditures have been made in an aggregate amount or value in excess of \$50, with the amount, date and purpose of each expenditure. Since a credit card was used to make payments to vendors, an amended Schedule C must be filed itemizing the name and amount paid to each vendor by credit card.
