1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Everygy Employee PowerPAC reports making a \$250 contribution to Barbara Wasinger on 9-27-19. This contribution was not reported by your campaign. If this contribution was received, it must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2020 report. This error will cause the cash balance on the front page summary sheet to be incorrect. Therefore, an amended front page summary sheet must also be filed. **If the campaign did not receive this contribution, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.**

2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2020 report lists a donation to the Free State PAC in the amount of \$50 on 2-22-19.

K.S.A. 25-4157a does not list a contribution made to a political action committee as one of the permissible uses of a candidate's campaign fund. If this expenditure was for a reimbursable campaign expense, that fact must be noted on an amended Schedule C. If this was an actual donation, the Free State PAC will be required to return your campaign funds or you will need to reimburse the campaign personally. **The return of this donation must be shown on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the July 27, 2020 report.**
