1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, Kansas Motor Carriers ProTruck PAC reports making a \$200 contribution to Owen Donohoe on 10-25-22. This contribution was not reported by your campaign. If this contribution was received, it must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2023 report. **If the campaign did not receive this contribution, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.**
2. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the amended July 25, 2022 Receipts and Expenditures Report lists a loan payable totaling \$20,000 to Owen Donohoe. The \$20,000 loan is not carried forward as a loan payable to the October 31, 2022 report or the January 10, 2023 report, nor is it disclosed on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements). **All loans should be listed on Schedule D (Other Transactions) until such time as they are repaid or forgiven.** An amended January 10, 2023 report must be filed disclosing the disposition of this debt.
3. The beginning balance of \$7,014.31 listed on the January 10, 2023 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$25,357.96 listed on the amended October 31, 2022 report. This difference of \$18,343.65 must be explained in an amended report.
4. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Kansas Republican Party reports receiving a \$17,677.79 check from Owen Donohoe on 11-18-22. This expenditure was not reported by your campaign. If this expenditure was made, it must be reported on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) on the January 10, 2023 report. **If the campaign did not make this expenditure, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.**
