As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the July 25, 2022 report lists expenses incurred by Brad Boyd and Nikki McDonald during this reporting period totaling \$162.10. However, these expenses are also listed on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements). If these expenditures were paid for personally and were not paid by the campaign account or deposited into the campaign account, they must be reported on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions), not Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) or Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements). Only contributions deposited in the campaign bank account and expenditures made from that account are to be reported on Schedules A and C. They are to remain **also** on Schedule D (Other Transactions) until they are paid or forgiven. An amended report must be filed correcting this error.
2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 25, 2022 report lists a donation to the Johnson County Democratic Women in the amount of \$40 on 6-17-22 for membership fees.

K.S.A. 25-4157a does not list a contribution made to a political action committee as one of the permissible uses of a candidate's campaign fund. If this expenditure was for a reimbursable campaign expense, that fact must be noted on an amended Schedule C. If this was an actual donation, the Johnson County Democratic Women will be required to return your campaign funds or you will need to reimburse the campaign personally. **The return of this donation must be shown on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the October 31, 2022 report.**
