K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for member of the house of representatives, . . . \$500 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Benson campaign reported receiving a \$500 contribution on 10-11-2024 and a \$500 contribution on 10-23-24 from the KS Building and Construction Trades Council. These contributions were received during the general election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$500. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. Since the campaign account has been closed, it will be necessary for the candidate to reimburse the \$500 to the KS Building and Construction Trades Council personally. A copy of the cancelled check must be provided to the Commission.
