1. The beginning balance of \$3,697.40 listed on the January 10, 2024 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$3,547.40 listed on the January 10, 2023 report. An amended January 10, 2024 report must be filed correcting this \$150.00 discrepancy.
2. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the United Health Group Inc., PAC reports making a \$250 contribution on 8-14-23 to Underhill for Kansas House. This contribution was not reported by your campaign. If this contribution was received, it must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2024 report. **If the campaign did not receive this contribution, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.**
3. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2024 report lists three expenditures to Jeff Underhill for reimbursement for dry cleaning. K.S.A. 25-4157a states that campaign funds may not be used for “the personal use of the candidate”. These reimbursements are considered a personal benefit of the candidate and has no direct connection with or effect upon the campaign of the candidate of the holding of public office. It will be necessary for the candidate to personally reimburse the campaign account for the dry cleaning. The reimbursement must be shown on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the July 29, 2024 report.
