Dear Ms Williams:

I am writing in response to two November 5, 2009, letters regarding apparent omissions on the Jan. 10, 2009, receipts and expenditures report of the PAC Kansans for Lifesaving Cures. The letters point out three transactions:

1. A \$12,000 contribution dated Oct. 11, 2008, to the Kansas Democratic Party. This contribution was incorrectly reported by the party; the contribution came not from the PAC Kansans for Lifesaving Cures but from the Kansas Coalition for Lifesaving Cures, at the time a Kansas nonprofit 501(c)(4) corporation (since dissolved).
2. A \$3,000 contribution dated Oct. 28, 2008, to the Kansas Democratic Party. This contribution was incorrectly reported by the party; the contribution came not from the PAC Kansans for Lifesaving Cures but from the Kansas Coalition for Lifesaving Cures, at the time a Kansas nonprofit 501(c)(4) corporation (since dissolved).
3. A \$250 contribution dated Sept. 24, 2008, to the campaign of Sen. James Barnett. No such contribution was made.
