
In 2009 I started a Political Action Committee called **FreedomPAC**. I was the registered owner of the PAC.

In 2013, the legislature passed a bill which would prohibit any *new* PACs from being formed by the legislative leadership or by legislators. Upon asking for clarification of the legislation, I was informed that I was legal as my PAC was formed in 2009 and prior to my intent to run as a legislator. Subsequently in 2014, the legislature passed legislation prohibiting any legislator from owning a PAC.

I have closed my website (FreedomPAC.net) and my web host has been terminated. The monetary balance of \$48.66 will be used to cover administrative fees, and will be reported (if required) on the final filing report.

I request that you officially close out (un-register) my PAC effective upon receipt of this letter.
