**Errors/Omissions:**

Schedule C must be amended to provide detail for independent expenditures. The Kansas Campaign Finance Act requires that independent expenditures in excess of \$300 must show the amount, date, purpose, and the name and address of the supported or opposed candidate for each expenditure.

*Under the Kansas Campaign Finance Act, an independent expenditure is defined as “an expenditure that is made without the cooperation or consent of the candidate or agent of such candidate intended to be benefited and which expressly advocates the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for state or local office”.*
