**NOTIFICATION OF FAILURE TO FILE AMENDED  
JANUARY 10, 2022 AND JULY 25, 2022 RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES  
REPORTS**

In checking with the Secretary of State, we have been informed that you have failed to file **Amended January 10, 2022 and July 25, 2022 Receipts and Expenditures Reports** as required by K.S.A 25-4148. The Report must be completed and filed within five (5) days from the date of this notice.

As provided by K.S.A. 25-4152, you have until **January 5, 2023**, which is 15 days from the date of this notice, to comply with the reporting requirements before a civil penalty is imposed - \$10 per day the required document remains unfiled. No civil penalty shall exceed three hundred dollars (\$300). Also, there are criminal penalties for intentionally failing to file. The intentional failure to file the required Report within five (5) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures until the required Report has been filed.

File the required Report within five (5) days with the Secretary of State. As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's office.
