
Dear Carol Williams,

The Betts for the Future Campaign received an errors and omission report detailing an error found on our January 10, 2007 report. According to the commission our ending balance on the January 10, 2006 report did not match that of our beginning balance on the 2007 report. We initially assumed that this error was a result of checks that were later discovered and deposited into the account after the 2007 reporting period deadline; however, this was not the case.

We noticed on the January 10, 2005 report that the ending balance of \$2501.38 did not match the beginning balance of \$3501.38 on the January 10, 2006 report. After carefully reviewing the reports, we found another error. We did not calculate our un-itemized contributions of \$1656.26 nor did we add the contribution for \$250 (discussed in the filed amended report) totaling \$1906.26 which would have brought the ending balance to \$4407.64.

These errors would explain why our report was inaccurate by \$906.40. We have readjusted our figures and the calculations are on track. Along with this report, I will attach the front covers of the January 2005, and January 2006 reports. The January 2007, report is accurate. Thank you for bringing these issues to our attention. Because of your attentiveness, we were able to discover another error. Please keep us advised if there is another issue that needs to be resolved.

The Betts for the Future Campaign received an errors and omission report detailing to errors made. According to schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) there was a contribution check for \$250 received on April 4, 2005, in actuality the check was written on September 4, 2004, and deposited on April 4, 2005 because this is when the check was discovered. After calling a representative with the Governmental Ethics Commission, we were told to deposit the check and make note of it on the January 2006 report. Enclosed you will find a copy of this check dated September 22, 2004 from the SEDGPAC.

It has also been brought to our attention that there were two checks that weren't reported on the 2006 report (Kansas Beverage Association PAC and Kansas Health Care Association PAC). According to our records, we do not have these checks on file as being received. We will be sure to follow up with these two PACS to make sure the checks were not lost or misplaced on their part, however, our records don't reflect such a deposit. As soon as we make contact with the lobbyist pertaining to these contributions, we will certainly notify you.

Thank you for bringing these issues to our attention, we are very careful as to the maintenance of our records, and if there are any other unresolved issues that may come in the future please do not hesitate to call or write.
