K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Vratil campaign reported receiving four separate \$300 in-kind contributions for polling from Jayhawk Consulting Services, Inc. during the primary election period totaling \$1200.00.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted an in-kind contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$200. We would suggest that the \$200 for the in-kind contribution be reimbursed immediately. The reimbursement of this in-kind contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
