

As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. The computer printout used for Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) does not contain a column indicating whether the contribution is in the form of cash, check, loan or other. Each entry on Schedule A must be amended to reflect whether the contribution was made by check, cash, was a loan, or other.

2. The Campaign Finance Act requires that any contribution from an individual in excess of \$150 must be accompanied by the occupation and industry of the individual. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the report does not contain that information. The report must be amended to show both the occupation and the industry of all contributors who gave in excess of \$150.

3. K.S.A. 25-4148 (b) (7) requires that when an expenditure is made by payment to an advertising agency, public relations firm or political consultants for disbursement to vendors, the report of such expenditure shall show in detail the name of each such vendor and the amount, date and purpose of the payment to each. Expenditures amounting to \$29,045.38 were made to Manhattan Advertising Agency for advertising. Please submit the required supplemental information as an amendment to Schedule C on the October 27, 2008 Receipts and Expenditures Report.

4. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the report lists expenditures that were previously reported on the July 28, 2008 report. An amended Schedule C must be filed that contains only the activity that occurred from July 25, 2008 through October 23, 2008.
