

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The McGinn campaign reported receiving the following contributions during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted contributions in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$1250. We would suggest that these contributions be refunded immediately. The return of these contributions should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2010 Receipts and Expenditures Report.

2. The July 28, 2008 report listed a contribution being received during session from Occidental Oil & Gas Corporation in the amount of \$200. The return of this contribution was not shown on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 27, 2008 report. If the contribution was returned, an amended October 27, 2008 report must be filed listing the disbursement. However, if the contribution has not been returned, please return it as soon as possible and show it on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2010 report.
