Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Lynn campaign reported receiving the following contributions:

All of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted contributions in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$2750. These contributions must be refunded immediately. The return of these contributions should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 30, 2012 Receipts and Expenditures Report.

2. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the following PACs report making contributions to the Lynn campaign:

These contributions were not reported by your campaign. If these contributions were received, they must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2012 report. These errors will cause the cash balance on the front page summary sheet to be incorrect. Therefore, an amended front page summary sheet must also be filed. If the campaign did not receive these contributions, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

3. K.A.R. 19-29-3(a)(4) states that illegibility of a receipts and expenditures report is a material error or omission in a report. K.S.A. 25-4148 (e) further states that the Commission may require any treasurer to file an amended report for any period for which the original report filed by such treasurer contains material errors or omissions.

Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2012 Receipts & Expenditures Report filed by the Julia Lynn for Senate campaign is not on a form prescribed by the Commission. All pertinent information must be contained on the same page. An amended Schedule C must be filed with the date, name and address, purpose of the expenditure or disbursement and the amount on the same page.

4. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2012 report contains an addition error. The expenditures listed total \$13,263.37, not \$16,922.54 as indicated on the cover summary page. This difference of \$3,659.17 must be explained in an amended report.
