Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the October 29, 2012 report lists an expenditure to the Mike Burgess for State Representative campaign for \$500 on 10-25-12 as a “Campaign Donation”.

K.S.A. 25-4157a (c) states, “No candidate or candidate committee shall accept from any other candidate or candidate committee for any candidate for local, state, or national office, any moneys received by such candidate or candidate committee as a campaign contribution . . . “ Since this was a donation to the candidate’s campaign committee, the Mike Burgess campaign will be required to return your campaign funds.

Since the campaign account is closed, it will be necessary for you to endorse the returned Mike Burgess campaign check to a charity, your political party, or to a former contributor. A letter of acknowledgment from the recipient of this endorsed check must be provided to the Commission.
