Schedule C (Expenditures & Other Disbursements) of the October 29, 2012 Receipts & Expenditures Report shows expenditures totaling \$349.48 for "Dress Clothes for Photos".

K.S.A. 25-4157a states that campaign funds may not be used for "the personal use of the candidate". The Commission has consistently held that clothing by its very nature is personal. Using campaign funds to purchase clothing is not a legitimate use of campaign funds. In Opinion No. 96-16, the Commission stated that the purchase or renting of formal wear for governmental and political functions is not a permissible use of campaign funds. Since the campaign account is closed, it will be necessary for the candidate to personally contribute the \$349.48 to a charitable organization, to a party committee or returned as a refund in whole or in part to any contributor or contributors from whom received or paid into the general fund of the state. A copy of the cancelled check must be sent to the Commission.
