Subject Report- Period of July 22, 2016 thru October 27, 2016

Item No. 1- \$1,000 contribution from IBEW PAC Educational Fund determined by the commission to be in excess of the limit set for the primary election period.

Resolution: as prescribed in your instructions, this contribution was refunded with check no. 1031 dated August 8, 2017. A copy of the refund check enclosed herewith.

Item No. 2- Two contributions (Kansas Realtors PAC- \$250 and Kansas New Energy PAC- \$1,000) were reported to the commission by the contributing parties, however, they were not disclosed on the report filed by the Laura Kelly campaign for the corresponding period.

Resolution: the Kelly campaign has no record of receiving either check.

Item No. 3- a detailed accounting of disbursements totaling \$68,097 made by Mary Christine & Associates (an advertising agency) was not submitted with the report.

Resolution: as prescribed in your instructions, a schedule detailing the required supplemental information is enclosed herewith.

1. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Kelly campaign reported receiving a \$1000 contribution on 12-30-15 from the IBEW PAC Educational Fund, and an additional \$1000 on 8-1-16, for a total of \$2000. Both of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$1000. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2018 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
