- 1. According to the January 10, 2016 report filed by the Kansas Chamber of Commerce Jobs PAC, they report giving a \$100 in-kind contribution for a voter list to the Julia Lynn campaign. If the campaign received this voter list, an amended Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions) must be filed listing this in-kind contribution.
- 2. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a) (1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Lynn campaign reported receiving the following contributions during the primary election period:
