1. The cover summary page for the January 10, 2017 report indicates \$664.41 in contributions. However, the contributions listed on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) total \$604.41. Also, the expenditures listed on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) total \$16,086.36, not \$16,517.40 as indicated on the cover summary page. An amended report must be filed explaining these discrepancies.

2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) lists a \$394.41 contribution from Little & Co. The full amount of the contribution received via credit card from Web-based payment processing vendors must be reported on Schedule A. The fee charged by the payment processing company is reported as an expenditure even though the campaign does not actually make a payment for these fees. Schedule A must be amended to show the full amount of the contribution from Little & Co.
