K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The O'Donnell campaign reported receiving a \$1000 contribution on 11-2-13 from Kevin Mullen, and \$1000 on 7-16-14, for a total of \$2000. In addition, a \$50 contribution was received on 11-11-13 from Ann Ross and an additional \$1000 on 12-1-14. All of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted contributions in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$1050.00. We would suggest that these contribution be refunded immediately. The return of these contributions should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2016 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
