1. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Lynn campaign reported receiving a \$250 contribution on 8-18-17, a \$250 on 10-4-19, a \$500 on 12-11-19 and another \$500 contribution on 7-27-20 from RAI Services Company, for a total of \$1500. All of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$500. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. **The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2022 Receipts and Expenditures Report.**

2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) lists expenditures for legal fees on 9-15-20 to Krieghauser Law in the amount of \$15,025.50 and \$11,940.00 to Ney Law Firm. Further explanation for these expenditures must be provided in a letter to the Commission.
