1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, Liberty PAC reports making a \$500 contribution to Richard Hilderbrand on 10-6-20. This contribution was not reported by your campaign. However, a \$500 contribution was reported as received from Liberty Utilities PAC in Joplin, Missouri on 10-8-20. The Liberty Utilities PAC did not report giving this contribution. If this contribution was incorrectly reported, an amended Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) must be filed listing the correct donor. **If the campaign did not receive the \$500 contribution from Liberty PAC, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.**
  
2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) indicates your campaign accepted the following cash contribution over \$100:

K.S.A. 25-4153(i) states, "No person shall make any contribution or contributions to any candidate or the candidate committee of any candidate in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 for any one primary or general election, and no candidate or candidate committee of any candidate shall accept any contribution or contributions in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 from any one person for any one primary or general election."

The cash contribution listed above should not have been accepted by the campaign. In the future, you must be certain that all contributions in excess of \$100 are made by check, cashier's check, money order or e-funds.
