1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Kansas Realtors PAC reports making a \$1000 contribution on 8-5-20 and the Kansas State Council PAC reports making a \$200 contribution on 7-26-20 to the Hensley campaign. These contributions were not reported by your campaign. If these contributions were received, they must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the October 26, 2020 report. These omissions will cause the cash balance on the front page summary sheet to be incorrect. Therefore, an amended front page summary sheet must also be filed. **If the campaign did not receive these contributions, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.**
2. According to the Candidate Last Minute Contribution Report filed on 7-30-20 by the Anthony Hensley campaign, the campaign received a \$700 contribution on 7-28-20 from the Humane Society Legislative Fund and a \$500 contribution on 7-28-20 from RAI Services Company. These contributions were not reported by your campaign on the October 26, 2020 report. These contributions must **also** be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the October 26, 2020 report. These errors will cause the cash balance on the front page summary sheet to be incorrect. Therefore, an amended front page summary sheet must also be filed.
3. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Hensley campaign reported receiving a \$250 contribution on 8-4-17, \$250 on 10-18-19, \$500 on 12-21-19 and an additional \$500 on 7-28-20 from RAI Services Company, for a total of \$1500. All of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$500. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. **The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2022 Receipts and Expenditures Report.**

4. K.S.A. 25-4148 (b) (7) requires that when an expenditure is made by payment to an advertising agency, public relations

firm or political consultants for disbursement to vendors, the report of such expenditure shall show in detail the name of each such vendor and the amount, date and purpose of the payment to each. Expenditures in the amount of \$47,300.00 were made to CounterPoint Messaging, LLC during the reporting period. Please submit the required supplemental information as an amendment to Schedule C on the October 26, 2020 Receipts and Expenditures Report.
