Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. The beginning balance of \$20,423.17 listed on the January 10, 2018 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$20,323.17 listed on the January 10, 2017 report. This difference of \$100.00 must be explained in an amended report.
2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2018 report lists a donation to the South Sedgwick County Democrat Club in the amount of \$25 on 10-28-17.

K.S.A. 25-4157a does not list a contribution made to a political action committee as one of the permissible uses of a candidate's campaign fund. If this expenditure was for the purchase of an advertisement in the committee's publications or for other reimbursable campaign expenses, that fact must be noted on an amended Schedule C. If this was an actual donation, the South Sedgwick County Democrat Club will be required to return your campaign funds or you will need to reimburse the campaign personally. The return of this donation must be shown on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2019 report.
