1. K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee . . . shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator, . . . \$1000 for each primary election . . . and an equal amount for each general election." The Ware campaign reported receiving a \$500 contribution on 10-1-19, and a \$1000 contribution on 7-29-20 from the Building & Construction Trades Council of Central & Western Kansas, for a total of \$1500. Both of these contributions were received during the primary election period.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted a contribution in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$500. We would suggest that this contribution be refunded immediately. **The return of this contribution should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2022 Receipts and Expenditures Report.**

2. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the **amended** October 26, 2020 report the campaign filed on October 29, 2020 lists duplicate entries for the loans owed to Mary Ware. An amended Schedule D for the October 26, 2020 report must be filed removing the duplicate entries.
