1. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2024 report lists expenditures totaling \$3,038.44, yet the cash available this period indicates a balance of \$2,090.00. An amended January 10, 2024 report must be filed disclosing the source of funds used to make \$948.44 in expenditures. Expenditures made by the candidate from personal funds which are not deposited into a campaign bank account are to be reported on Schedule B as in-kind contributions from the candidate. **Only contributions deposited in the campaign bank account and expenditures made from that account are to be reported on Schedules A and C.**

2. Schedule D (Other Transactions) of the January 10, 2024 Receipts and Expenditures Report shows a loan payable totaling \$13,472.00 to Bryan Zesiger on 12-28-23. All loans should also be listed on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) if the funds were deposited into the campaign bank account. If the campaign loan is for expenditures made from personal funds, not deposited into the campaign bank account and not reimbursed by the campaign, the personal expenditures must be itemized on Schedule B (In-Kind Contributions). An amended report must be filed which includes this loan on Schedule A or Schedule B.

3. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) indicates your campaign accepted the following cash contribution over \$100:

K.S.A. 25-4153(i) states, "No person shall make any contribution or contributions to any candidate or the candidate committee of any candidate in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 for any one primary or general election, and no candidate or candidate committee of any candidate shall accept any contribution or contributions in the form of money or currency of the United States which in the aggregate exceeds \$100 from any one person for any one primary or general election."

The cash contribution listed above should not have been

accepted by the campaign. In the future, you must be certain that all contributions in excess of \$100 are made by check, cashier's check, money order or e-funds. **No amendment is required for this error.**
