1. The beginning balance of \$2,840.32 listed on the January 10, 2022 report is not the same as the ending balance of \$6,354.30 listed on the amended January 10, 2021 report filed on August 6, 2021. An amended front page summary sheet for the January 10, 2022 report must be filed with the correct beginning balance.
2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the January 10, 2022 Receipts and Expenditures Reports lists two E Fund contributions. It appears the full amount of the contributions are not reported on the e-fund contributions. An amended Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) must be filed with the full amount of the contributions which includes the fees. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) must be amended to include the fees charged by the payment processing company.
3. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the January 10, 2022 report lists reimbursement of the \$1000 loan owed to the candidate. Since the loan was repaid, it does not need to be listed on Schedule D (Other Transactions). An amended Schedule D (Other Transactions) must be filed removing the \$1000 loan payable.
