K.S.A. 25-4153 (a)(1) states, "The aggregate amount contributed to a candidate and such candidate's committee... shall not exceed the following: for the office of state senator or member of the state board of education, ... \$1000 for each primary election ... and an equal amount for each general election." The Erickson campaign reported receiving the following contributions:

These contributions were received during the primary election period which is January 1, 2021 through August 6, 2024 for senators.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-4153, the campaign accepted contributions in excess of the legal limit amounting to \$750. We would suggest that these contributions be refunded immediately. The return of these contributions should be noted on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) of the July 29, 2024 report.

2. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, the Kansans For Quality Mental Health Services PAC reports making a \$250 contribution on 7-21-23 to Renee Erickson. This contribution was not reported by your campaign. If this contribution was received, it must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the January 10, 2024 report. If the campaign did not receive this contribution, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

3. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the January 10, 2024 Receipts and Expenditures Report lists numerous E Fund contributions. It appears the full amount of the contribution is not reported on some of the e-fund contributions. An amended Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) must be filed with the full amount of the contributions which includes the fee. The processing fees to WinRed are correctly reported on Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements).
