
Re: Campaign Finance Report

It has come to my attention that, due to a change in software, our previously filed campaign finance report includes nine instances of contributors who have given more than \$2,000 during the primary election.


We have notified the parties involved and reimbursements of the amount over \$2,000 are being sent to each contributor, and will be reflected in our July 2010 campaign finance report.
