

1. According to the reports filed with the Secretary of State, Plumbers & Pipefitters Local 441 PAC reports making a \$1000 contribution to Anthony Kotich on 7-23-14. This contribution was not reported by your campaign. If this contribution was received, it must be reported on Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) on the October 27, 2014 report. If the campaign did not receive this contribution, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

2. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) of the October 27, 2014 report lists a \$500 contribution received from Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen on 7-23-14 and an additional \$1000 contribution on 7-23-14. However, the verified statement filed by the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen PAC indicates the PAC gave one \$500 contribution to the Kotich campaign on 7-23-14. Please check your records to determine if the \$1000 contribution was from the PAC or if the \$1000 contribution was from another donor.
