The radio advertising that Michael Romaniszyn listed as an in-kind contribution was part of a bundle purchased by the Riley County Democratic Party for five candidates. Although the advertising ran prior to the election, the expenditure was not listed on our report because the provider, Manhattan Advertising, did not bill us until February 7. So, that expenditure will show up on our next report. (Just so you know, our party chair and I had been asking for the bill for months. We have spoken and written rather harshly to Deanna Hall, the woman who owns and runs the business about the bind she puts us in with her late billings. I hope that she takes heed and is more punctual should we use her again).

The expenditure to The Manhattan Mercury in the amount of \$559.53 on 10-30-08 was a "slate" ad picturing all the Democratic candidates and was tagged as being paid by the party and not authorized by any of the candidates or their committees. I am sending a copy of the ad for your information. I am also sending a corrected page with the candidate names listed. However, there is dissention among the ranks of the executive committee about whether an ad structured as this one was is just a party ad or one that requires candidates to report it as in-kind. Your ruling on that question will be helpful to us in the future.
