As provided by law, a copy of this notice has been made a part of your record in the Secretary of State's Office. The intentional failure to file an amended report within thirty (30) days is a class A misdemeanor. In addition, you may not accept contributions or make expenditures following the end of the thirty (30) day period if the amended report has not been filed.

Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Schedule A (Contributions and Other Receipts) must be amended to include the street or mailing address for all Contributors who gave in excess of \$50 to the committee during the reporting period.
2. Schedule C (Expenditures and Other Disbursements) must be amended to include the street or mailing addresses for all individuals and vendors to whom expenditures in excess of \$50 were made during the reporting period.
3. K.S.A. 25-4153 (f) states, "Any political funds which have been collected and were subject to the reporting requirements of the campaign finance act shall not be used in or for the campaign of a candidate for a federal elective office."

A review of the October 27, 2008 report indicates the Pottawatomie County Republican Central Committee gave \$1,250.00 to Lynn Jenkins on 8/22/2008.

Since the Act specifically states that a political committee may not make such a contribution, the committee must obtain a refund of these contributions immediately. The refund will then be shown on Schedule A (Contributions & Other Receipts) of the report filed by the committee for the time period in which the refund is received. A copy of the letter requesting the refund should be submitted to the Commission.
