Additional information and assistance may be obtained by writing or calling this office. If after having contacted this office substantial issues remain unresolved, you may within ten (10) days of receipt of this notice request a hearing before the Commission.

1. Pursuant to K.S.A 2008 Supp. 25-4148 (c) every political action committee or party committee must report the name and address of each candidate for state or local office who receives an in-kind contribution from the committee.

Michael Romaniszyn candidate for county commission reports receiving an in-kind contribution of \$168.00 for radio commercials on 11/4/2008 from your committee. An amended January 10, 2009 Receipts and Expenditures Report must be filed to show the expenditure. If your committee did not make the expenditure to benefit Michael Romaniszyn, please note this fact in a letter to the Commission.

2. Schedule C of the January 10, 2009 report lists an expenditure to the Manhattan Mercury in the amount of \$559.53 on 10/30/08 for advertising. If the advertising was an in-kind or an independent expenditure for a candidate for state or local office and the amount was in excess of \$300 the name and address of the candidate must be provided.
